





- **# Write as if you are a staff writer**Important things [Answer to the problem] in the first paragraph
  - Summary of the event/thing first so that it delivers message even though only that summary survives the "cutting"
  - Then expand your story after the <u>First Paragraph</u>
- **Similarity Check Similarity Check**

### ∺ Grading (*Main Body + <u>First</u> – <u>Similarity</u>)*

- Main body length MUST be at least 3 times longer than the first paragraph
- Main Body: 50% & First Paragraph: 50%
- <u>Similarity Deduction:</u> Similarity % will be deducted from the sum of two scores.
- $\triangle$  Example: 50% 50% 15%  $\rightarrow$  85% (final score)
- $\triangle$  Example: 40% 50% 5%  $\rightarrow$  85 % (final score)
