1. Must be concise progress reporting focused on the Progress and Milestones vs. Outcomes

2. Required components

- 1) A single paragraph of <u>summary</u> combining all 4 components described below (remember your editor who may read only this part, and a pair of scissors he may hold)
- 2) The <u>highlight</u> of the period, which includes, but is not limited to,
 - a) What went well over the last period
 - b) Key findings and results
 - c) Impacts of the results
- 3) The lowlight of the period, which includes, but is not limited to,
 - a) What did not go well during the period
 - b) Changes to be made in the approach
- 4) The <u>issues</u> of the period that have to be resolved, including, but are not limited to,
 - a) Barrier to be removed
 - b) Problems beyond team's scope or authority
- 5) Next period plan, which includes,
 - a) Areas to be focused next period
 - b) How lowlights and issues resolved
- 3. Bi-Weekly report format and submission
 - a) MS Word format with Times New Roman font size 10, with 1 inch margin all sides
 - b) Submission dates: Feb 3, Feb 17, Mar 2, Mar 23, Apr 6, and Apr 20 (by 5:00pm)
 - c) No extension, no late submission allowed (unless pre-approved)
